## EASEMENT

Fleming, heirs and assigns can have access at all times for any purpose to The West Fifteen Acres of the Southeast Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Eleven (11) in Township Seventy-five (75) North, Range Twenty-six (26) West of the 5th P. M., Madison County, Iowa, and this provision shall be a covenant running with the land.
