Reid and to her heirs and assigns forever, all--- right, title, interest, estate, claim and demand both at law and in equity as well as in possession as in expectancy, of, in and to the following described premises, to-wit: The southwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the southwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the south half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the northwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the southwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section twenty six (26) and the east six (6) rods of the east half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the southeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the southeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section twenty seven (27) and the east seven (7) acres, more or less of all that part of the west thirty four (34) rods of the east half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the southeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the southeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said section twenty seven (27) lying and being south and west of the public highway as now located and used across said land.
