The United State of America, To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting: Whereas, in pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 22d, 1852, entitled "An Act to make Bounty Land Warrants assignable, and for other purposes" Warrant No. 746 for 160 acres, issued in favor of Thomas I. White, Fairies in Captain Grumbles Company Texas Militia Indian War has been returned to the General Land Office, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the South East Quarter of Section Eight, in Township Seventy Seven North of Range Twenty six West, in the District of Lands, subject to sale at Fort Des Moines, Iowa, containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General: which has been assigned to Robert Heath. Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Robert Heath the tract of land above described; To have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Robert Heath, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Franklin Pierce, President of the United State of America, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
