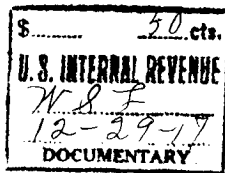

Know all men by these presents; That the township of South in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of Twelve 50/100 Dollars, in hand paid by Mrs Hulda Johnson of Madison county, and State of Iowa (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,) does hereby sell and convey unto the said Mrs Hulda Johnson the premises hereinafter described, situated in South township, in the County of Madison, and state of Iowa, for the purpose and upon the express condition that the same be used only as a place of interment, and be subject to the general regulations made, or to be made, for the government of the Township Cemeteries by the said township, and in violations of said conditions, or any of them, said premises shall revert to said township. Said premises are, described as lot numbered One hundred seventy eight (size in S part St Charles Cemetery, a plat of which is recorded on page 247 of Cemetery records 10 X 20 ft) in the office of the County Recorder of Madison county, Iowa. And the said township of South hereby covenants to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. In testimony whereof, the said township of South has hereunto caused these presents to be subscribed by the Township Trustees of said township.
