TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME GREETING:

Whereas, in pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 22d, 1852, entitled "An Act to make Bounty Land Warrants assignable, and for other purposes, Warrant No, 2981 for 40 acres issued in favor of Alexander M. Besse. Private in Captain Gardiner's Company Maine Militia, Arastook War; has been returned to the General Land Office, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the South East Quarter of the North West fractional quarter of Section eighteen, in Township seventy-four, of Range twenty-six in the District of Lands subject to sale at Chariton, Iowa, containing Thirty five Acres and sixty two hundredths of an acre according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office, by the Surveyor General Which has been assigned to Edward M. Greenway, Junior.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the United State, unto the said Edward M. Greenway, Junior the tract of land, above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Edward M. Greenway Junior, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I Franklin Pierce PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed;
