KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Naomi R. Shirley, formerly Naomi R. Delaplain, of the county of San Bernardino and state of California in consideration of the sum of one and 25/100 dollar, in hand paid by T.F. Ruth of the county of Madison and state of Iowa, do hereby QUIT CLAIM AND CONVEY unto the said T.F. RUTH all my right, title and interest in and to the following described premises, situated in the county of Madison and state of Iowa, to-wit;

The southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section twenty-seven (27) in township seventy-five (75) north; range twenty-seven (27) west of the 5th P.M. Iowa.

And the said Naomi R. Shirley states that she is the same and identical person as Naomi R. Delaplain, minor heir of Aaron H. Delaplain, deceased, to whom was patented from the United States the above described land, and other land, which patent was dated June 3, 1856, and recorded in Vol. 12, page 556 of the U.S. Records, and that he left surviving him as his only heirs this grantor, and Elizabeth Delaplain, his widow. And that this grantor is the same and identical person as the said Naomi R. Delaplain, Naomi Rosilla Diloplain, Naomi R. Deliplain, Naomi Deliplain, who conveyed said land by guardian deed, and who was named in the proceedings of said estate of Aaron H. Delaplain, deceased, or in the proceedings of the guardianship of this grantor, Naomi R. Delaplain, then a minor child.

And T.A. Shirley, husband of the said Naomi R. Shirley hereby relinquishes his right of dower in and to the above described premises.

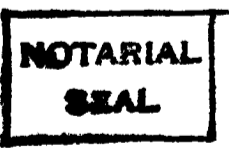
