WHEREAS, Royal Uran of Madison County, Iowa, has deposited in the office of the Register of the State Land Office, a Certificate of the County Auditor of Madison County, Iowa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Royal Uran according to law for

NOW KNOW YE, That the State of Iowa, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of the General Assembly, in such cases made and provided, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents does give and grant unto the said Royal Uran and to his heirs and assigns, the said tract of land above described, to have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto, belonging, unto the said Royal Uran and to his heirs and assigns forever.
