WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant NO. 15,935, for 40 acres, issued in favor of Samuel Saail private in Captains Munroe's Company, Massachusetts Militia War 1812. has been returned to the General Land Office, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the South East quarter of the South West Quarter of Section two, in Township seventy four North of Range Twenty seven west, in the District of lands, subject to sale at Chariton Iowa. Containing forty acres.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General; which has been assigned to Hawkins Judd.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Hawkins Judd the tract of Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Hawkins Judd, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I Franklin Pierce, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
