Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States, " Warrant No. 49,959 for 80 acres, issued in favor of Erwin Thompson, Private in Captain Jackson's Company Missouri Militia, Florida War. has been returned to the General Land Office, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the West half of the North west quarter of Section Seventeen in Township Seventy five North of Range twenty six west in the District of Lands, Subject to sale at

Chariton Iowa, containing eighty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General; which has been assigned to William C. Clarke.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said William C. Clarke the tract of Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said William C. Clarke and to his heirs and assigns forever.
