Weaver, late of Madison County, Iowa, deceased, for and in consideration of the sum of fourteen thousand six hundred and sixty five and 40/100 (14,665.40) dollars, in hand paid by C.M. Weaver of Madison County, do hereby sell and convey unto the said C.M. Weaver the following described real estate situated in Madison County, to-wit: the undivided four fifths of the following described real estate, to-wit; the east half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the north west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the west twenty (20) acres of the South 75.2 rods of the north west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the south east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ), and the east sixteen (16) acres of the north east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the south west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ), all in section ten (10), in township seventy six (76) north, of range twenty nine (29), west of the Fifth P.M. Iowa.

And we hereby covenant with the said C.M. Weaver that we hold said premises by good and perfect title; that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same; that they are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever.

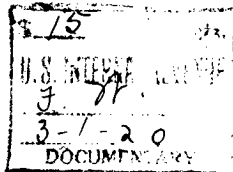

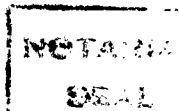
