TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME: GREETING:

WHEREAS, John Spurlock of Madison County, Iowa, has deposited in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Iowa, a Certificate of the School Fund Commissioner of Madison County, Iowa, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John Spurlock according to the provisions of the Act of the General Assembly of the 25th of February 1847, entitled "An Act to Provide for the Management and Disposition of the School Fund", for The South East quarter of Section Twenty five (25) Township Seventy six (76) North, Range Twenty eight (28) West of the 5th Principal Meridian, Containing One Hundred & Sixty (160) acres.

according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land office of the United States, by the Surveyor-General which said tract has been purchased by the said John Spurlock

NOW KNOW YE, That the State of Iowa, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of the General Assembly, in such cases made and provided, Have Given and Granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John Spurlock and to his heirs, and assigns, the said tract of land above described, to have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said John Spurlock and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof I Stephen Hempstead Governor of the State of Iowa, has caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of the State of Iowa to be hereunto affixed.
