Whereas William C. McCall of Madison County, Iowa, has deposited in the office of the Register of the State Land Office, a Certificate of the School Fund Commissioner of Madison County, Iowa, whereby it appears that full payment, has been made by the said William C. McCall according to the provisions of the Act of the General Assembly of the 25th day of February, 1917, entitled, "An act to Provide for the Management and Disposition of the School Fund" for

The South West quarter of Section Number Sixteen in Township Number Seventy six North, of Range Number Twenty nine West of the Fifth Principal Meridian

Containing One Hundred and Sixty (160) Acres according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office of the United States, by the Surveyor-General, and to the office of the School Fund Commissioner aforesaid by the Township Trustees; which said tract has been purchased by the said William C. McCall

Now Know Ye, That the State of Iowa, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of the General Assembly, in such cases made and provided, Have Given and Granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said William C. McCall and to his heirs and assigns, the said tract of land above described, to have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said William C. McCall and to his heirs and assigns forever.
