Livingston the premises hereinafter described, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, for the purpose, and upon the express condition that the same be used only as a place of interment, and be subject to the general regulations made, or to be made, for the government of the Moon Cemetery of the Township of Grand River, and in violation of said conditions, or any of them, said premises shall revert to said Township. Said premises are, and are described as lot numbered 347 of the Addition of 1914, to the Moon Cemetery of the Township of Grand River, a plat of which is recorded on page 314 of Book No. 22 Deed Records, in the office of the County Recorder of Madison County, Iowa. And the said Township of Grand River hereby covenants to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
