The Grantee herein being a child of said deceased and his interest in said real estate being an undivided one-twelfth (1/12).

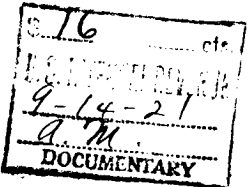
