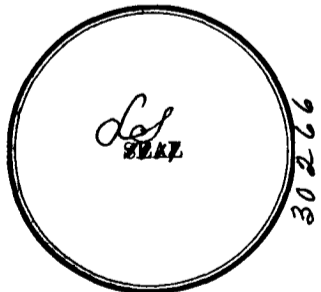
having deposited in the General Land Office, a warrant in his favor, numbered 10.824

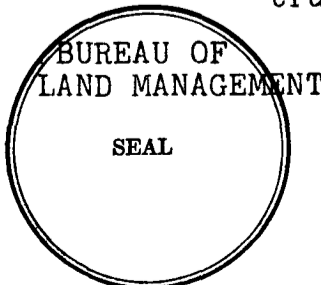
